You may pay the reduced tuition in full with the application. The tuition balance must be paid in full no later than **one week before class begins** or your registration will be cancelled and the \$20 deposit will be forfeited. The scholarship application and letter of recommendation must be received no later than **two weeks before the start of the term**. Registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.
